**Registered Nurse Adjunct Instructor Positions for
Expanded Access Program:
Using Technology to Train Nurses in Our Rural Communities**

As part of a 3-year Department of Labor Grant Project, WVUP is looking for Registered Nurses to staff CNA training programs in Tyler, Pleasants, Roane, Ritchie, Wood, and Jackson Counties.

POSITION DUTIES

- Instruct in course for nursing assistants, either in classroom, lab, or clinical settings;
- Attend Educate the Educator training to attain certification to teach nursing assistants; and
- Attend team training and team building sessions as scheduled.

EDUCATION/KNOWLEDGE

- An Associate's Degree in Nursing from a recognized, regionally accredited college or university;
- West Virginia RN licensure or eligibility for such licensure; and
- Ability to use technology in instructional delivery.

EXPERIENCE

- Two years experience as an RN, with at least one year (12-month full time employment or 2000 hours) in an approved long-term care facility; and
- Teaching experience is desired.

PARTICULARS

- This position will be a part-time hourly adjunct faculty position to work as needed at a reimbursement of \$25.00/hour.
- Days and hours will vary throughout the calendar year; will include weekdays, weekends and/or evenings.
- This is a 3-year Department of Labor grant. It is the goal of the program to become self sufficient and to continue the program after the expiration of grant funding.
